Counsel for Amergen (who called us this past Monday at the NRC's request) has told us that they included Treasury in its list of agencies to be contacted for documents because they were "casting a wide net" and thought Treasury "might" have responsive documents. Given the lack of any apparent connection between the subject matter of the "consistency appeal" at issue and the activities of the Treasury Department, Treasury is unaware of any responsive documents in its possession and believes it has no such documents. Therefore, in the absence of any specific indication that Treasury actually has responsive documents (and where they might be found within Treasury), Treasury is not undertaking to search for responsive documents. If the NRC comes upon any materials indicating that a specific entity within Treasury has responsive materials, please feel free to contact us again.
