Subject: Amendment to NRC License SNM-1513

Dear Ms. Adams,

Our current license SNM-1513 license provides for the possession and use of special nuclear material within our Californium Flux Multiplier (CFX). In our letter dated July 17, 2006, we notified your office that we ceased normal operations/activities specified in our license and that we will be proceeding with the formal decommissioning process. Our plan is to first remove and ship our NRC licensed material followed by the decommissioning of the facility. In order to implement this plan, we request an amendment to our license that permits:


1. Disassembly of necessary portions of the CFX to obtain access to the fuel assembly.
2. Removal of the fuel, packaging and transportation of the fuel to a licensed facility for disposal.

In addition, I will be resuming the role of Radiation Safety Officer for this license. I previously held this position from 1987-1992 and have been the chairman of the Company's Radiation Safety Committee since 1997. A summary of my qualifications is included with the license amendment application. Our decommissioning plan for the facility will be forthcoming.

We respectfully request an expedited review of this application.
