Enclosed is AEC Source Material License No. SMB-920. This license will expire September 30, 1967.

Please note that this license does not authorize disposal of source material except as provided by Section 20.301 of 10 CFR 20. In this regard, Mr. Robert G. Gallagher of Applied Health Physics requested in his letter of March 10, 1967, on your behalf, an exemption to Section 20.301 of 10 CFR 20 to permit disposal of the tin slag residues in a manner not otherwise authorized by 10 CFR 20. This request for exemption is presently under review.

Please note also that Item 11 of the license requires by June 30, 1967, a report to be submitted to us indicating the results of surveys conducted during start-up of your activities.
