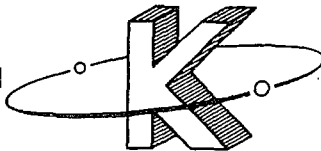

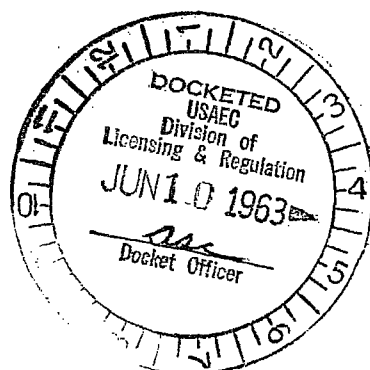
We realize that this license is for storage of the material only, and would appreciate your early attention to this matter as the ship is due to dock in the middle of June.

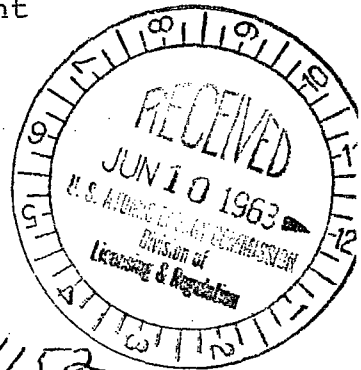
