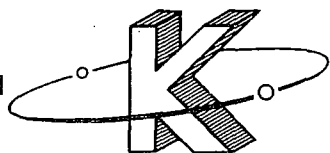

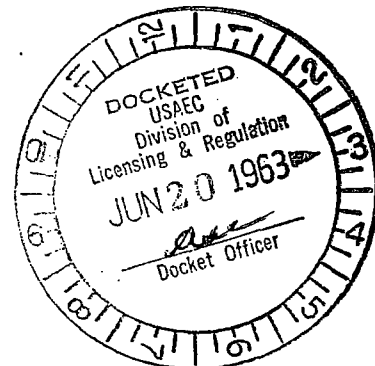

Gentlemen:

As requested by Mr. Robert Layfield, we wish to confirm that we propose to store the tin slags at Baltimore in bulk form.

The material is heavy, granulated, and like glass frits. It is also wet. There is, therefore, no danger whatever of dusting.

As you will recall, an analysis made several months ago showed the material to contain 0.05% thorium oxide. We believe that there is no danger whatever in the storing of the material in the manner in which we have proposed and would, therefore, respectfully request your approval of the new storage location.

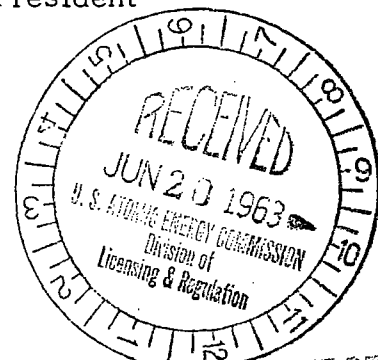
