Reply to a Notice of Violation

August 7, 2007

Gentlemen:

This letter is in response to the Notice of Violation from the inspection 030201/2007001 conducted by Judith A. Joustra on June 20, 2007 at Dominion Terminal Associates license # 45-21285-01.

- A. 10 CFR 20.1101(c) requires that the licensee periodically (at least annually) review the radiation safety program content and implementation.

The following actions were taken to correct this oversight.

1. Completed annual review on June 26, 2007.
  2. To prevent a recurrence of this, we have added the annual review to our computerized maintenance management scheduling system. The system will notify us the review is due and will track it until it has been completed.
- B. Condition of license # 45-21285-01 requires that the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representation, and procedures contained in it's application dated March 7, 2003 and letter dated July 2, 2003.
1. Item 10 of the licensee's application dated March 7, 2003, requires that the licensee will either perform a prospective evaluation demonstrating that unmonitored individuals are not likely to receive, in one year, a radiation dose in excess of 10% of the allowable limits in 10CFR Part 20 or will provide dosimetry that meets the criteria in Nureg - 1556, Volume 4 date October 1998.

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
We believe that the evaluation may have been done but acknowledge that we were unsuccessful in finding a report. If we should find the report in the future, we will provide it to you. In the meantime, we needed to have a new evaluation completed. An evaluation has been completed and submitted to Ms. Joustra on June 25, 2007. She has reviewed and accepted it. A copy has been placed in our file for future reference.

2. Letter dated July 2, 2003 requires that people using materials, authorized users will have successfully completed the training described in section entitled, "Authorized User" in NUREG- 1556, Volume 4, dated October 1998.

We have scheduled a training class to be given by the gauge manufacturer (Ronan) on August 14, 2007 that meets the NRC requirements for "Authorized Users". Only those employees receiving this training will be authorized users. In conjunction with this training, we will issue a directive that no other personnel will be authorized to perform work relating to the relevant equipment. Any new hires at DTA that are to become authorized users will be first trained in accordance with NRC "Authorized Users" requirements.

Full compliance for the above listed items will be August 15 after the training course has been completed. If you have any questions please contact John Campbell at 757 245-2275 ext 321.
