Dear Ms. Vietti-Cook:

In accordance to the NRC's rulemaking process, I'm writing to submit my comment in support for Petition PRM-50-85.

The petitioner asks the NRC to require that all host school pick-up centers be at a minimum distance of five to ten miles beyond the radiation plume exposure boundary zone to ensure that all school children are protected in the event of a radiological emergency.

The current regulations allow host school pick-up centers to be too close to the EPZ even though DHLS (formally FEMA) recommendations are for relocation centers to be five to ten miles beyond the EPZ.

The remedies the petitioner seeks are in accordance with DHLS own recommendations and would provide a greater measure of safety for the public.
