Please be advised that ISL uranium recovery is permitted only in groundwater aquifers that cannot supply drinking water, and that each facility must receive approval from the US Environmental Protection Agency (or state equivalent) to use a particular water source. And before receiving an NRC license, a company must describe in detail its plans for restoring the aquifer once ISL operations are completed.
