SUBJECT: INTERIM IMPLEMENTATION OF FINGERPRINTING
REQUIREMENTS IN SECTION 652 OF THE ENERGY POLICY
ACT OF 2005 FOR INCREASED CONTROLS LICENSEES

In Staff Requirements Memorandum (SRM) SECY-07-0011, "Interim Implementation of Fingerprinting Requirements in Section 652 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005," dated March 12, 2007, the Commission directed the staff to expeditiously engage the Agreement States to develop a plan to require fingerprinting of licensees Increased Controls with a goal of issuing the requirements as enhancements to the Increased Controls within 6 months. Additionally, the Commission requested the staff to keep the Commission fully informed of the progress and any significant difficulties. The staff worked diligently with the Agreement States to form a working group and steering committee, which include Agreement State representatives, to implement the Commission's direction. The staff issued generic communications to Increased Controls licensees and interacted with external stakeholders to seek their feedback on implementation issues.

The staff has identified significant implementation issues that could potentially impact the way the fingerprinting requirements are implemented. By way of this memo, the staff is notifying the Commission that resolving these issues will delay issuance of the fingerprinting Orders past the Commission's goal of September 12, 2007. The staff plans to forward a paper outlining the issues for the Commission's consideration and direction by the end of September 2007.
