SUMMARY

- Q What was your involvement with the I-125 seed event on 11/3/98?
- A He received the sterilizer pig in the "wash room" with other surgical instruments to clean. He couldn't remember if the sterilizer pig lid was on or off. Upon receipt, he tossed the entire sterilizer pig into a large sink that contained sudsy water. He believes that he wiped the sterilizer pig briefly before putting it in rinse water and then on a towel to air dry. He doesn't remember seeing the I-125 seeds.
- Q How long were your hands in the sink to clean the sterilizer pig and other instruments?
- A No more than one minute total.
