On June 27, 2007, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) held a public outreach meeting in Bay City, Texas, to make a presentation on and to answer questions about South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Company's plans to apply for a combined license for the construction and operation of two Advanced Boiling Water Reactors at the South Texas Project site, southwest of Houston, Texas. The applicants refer to these future units as STP Units 3 and 4.
