This refers to your letter dated October 4, 1978, which requested clarification of the license fee requirements for your Medical Center.

Enclosed is a copy of Part 170 of the Commission's regulations. The Medical Center holds two (2) NRC licenses - 20-02215-01 and 20-02215-02. These licenses are subject to fee Categories 7B and 7A, respectively, as specified in Sections 170.31 and 170.32 of the fee schedule. Therefore, your licenses would be subject to the following fees at the time you file an application for renewal or amendment, and upon completion of a routine inspection:

In your letter you also requested that the Medical Center be granted an exemption from payment of fees. The Commission has not previously granted exemption from fees for licenses issued to medical or teaching institutions who use byproduct material for human use, including nonprofit teaching hospitals. Since other medical and teaching institutions holding similar licenses pay fees in accordance with 10 CFR 170, we believe it would not be in the public's interest to grant an exemption from fees for your byproduct material licenses. If you have further questions concerning this matter, please let us know.
