Docket 50-482: Corrected Response to Request for Additional Information Regarding Severe Accident Mitigation Alternatives for Wolf Creek Generating Station

## Gentlemen:

Reference 1 submitted Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation's (WCNOC) application for renewal of the operating license for the Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS).

Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff identified in Reference 2, areas where additional information is needed to support the review of the Severe Accident Mitigation Alternatives (SAMA) analysis. WCNOC responded to the request for additional information in Reference 3.

An error was noted in the response WCNOC provided for question 3.c. in Reference 3. In an electronic mailing dated July 9, 2007, the NRC Environmental Project Manager for WCGS License Renewal requested that WCGS verify the data provided. WCNOC responded by an electronic mailing that in fact an error had been made in reporting the data and provided the corrected data. The individual plant examination of external events (IPEEE) value for Control Room (CR) is 1.43E-6 and not 6.31E-5 as reported. There was an actual increase in the CR contribution between the IPEEE and the fire re-analysis.
