SUBJECT: BWX TECHNOLOGIES, INC., AMENDMENT 2 - CONTAINER STORAGE FACILITY (TAC L31972)

Dear Ms. Morrell:

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has reviewed your application dated September 27, 2006, to amend License SNM-42, to authorize storage of components in a Container Storage Facility. Accordingly, the NRC License SNM-42, Safety Condition S-1, has been revised to include the dates of September 27, 2006; and February 20, May 4, June 20, and July 31, 2007.

In addition, License Condition S-2 is revised to read as follows:

The licensee shall maintain and execute the response measures in the Emergency Plan, Revision 19, dated April 15, 2007, or as further revised in accordance with 10 CFR 70.32(i).

Safeguards Condition SG-6.1 is also revised to read as follows:

The licensee shall follow the measures described in "BWX Technologies Nuclear Products Division, Physical Protection Plan (Plan)," dated March 15, 2007, submitted as Revision 9, and security procedures that are used to comply with the Plan as it may be further revised, in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(e).

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

Enclosed are copies of the revised Materials License SNM-42 (Enclosure 1, Non-public version) and the Safety Evaluation Report (Enclosure 2, non-public version), which includes the Categorical Exclusion determination.
