## Re: OPDES Permit OK0000191 Sequoyah Fuels Corporation

Dear Ms. Nambiar:

The ammonia permit limit of 10.5 mg/l was exceeded at Outfall 008 on July 1, 2007 when an ammonia analysis of 23.3 mg/l was measured. The laboratory reported this value to Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC) on August 8, 2007. Andy Potter of the Oklahoma Department Environmental Quality was notified by phone on August 8<sup>th</sup>. The source of this exceedances is contaminated water present in Pond 2. This is a continuation of a problem that has persisted for the past few months and was described in a letter to you dated June 14, 2007. Planned corrective actions were also described in that letter.
