

Dear Ms. Nambiar:

The nitrate permit limit of 32 mg/l was exceeded at Outfall 008 on July 3, 13 and 14, 2007 when nitrate analyses of 45.9, 66.4, and 107 mg/l, respectively, were measured. The laboratory reported these values to Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC) on August 9, 2007. Andy Potter of the Oklahoma Department Environmental Quality was notified by phone on August 9<sup>th</sup>. The source of these exceedances is contaminated water present in Pond 2. This is a continuation of a problem that has persisted for the past few months and was described in a letter to you dated June 14, 2007. Planned corrective actions were also described in that letter.
