Gentlemen:

Based on the information contained in your letters dated February 21 and April 29, 1985, and pursuant to §170.11(b)(1) of 10 CFR 170, the Commission hereby grants an exemption from fees in fee Category 3N for License 07-01579-19, having determined that such an exemption is authorized by law and is otherwise in the public interest. This exemption from fees relates to your request to amend the subject license to authorize the conduct of instrument calibrations for other licensees. Because, and as stated in your letters, the calibration services are provided as a courtesy to local licensees for which no fees are charged by either the University or the Radiation Safety Officer and, because of the encouragement of close relationships between the University's Radiation Safety Officers and local industry, we believe it to be in the public's interest to grant this exemption.

We have sent your application to the Licensing staff for processing.
