The second purpose of this letter is to establish documentation for our public record for that set of telephone conversations. As you recall, Mr. Daniel Mussatti called you on Monday, July 9 to get an accurate estimate for the annual wage for skilled craft workers. You called Mr. Daniel Mussatti back the next day and left a message that he was correct, the Southern estimate for skilled craft wages was too low (possibly for a laborer, where the wage and benefit packages are both lower than for skilled workers).
