Dear Mr. McDonald,

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received your letter dated August 21, 2007, regarding your activities at a temporary job-site in the State of Nebraska. Your NRC license states in License Condition 13.A., that you should notify this office in writing at least 14 days before initiating activities under your license at temporary job sites. The definition of temporary job site is defined in License Condition 10, which is anywhere in the United States where the NRC maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material, including areas of exclusive federal jurisdiction within Agreement States.

We appreciate your letter; however, in this case it is not necessary to provide a notification, since you are not working in NRC jurisdiction. Therefore, you will not have to notify us when your job is complete. If there are any questions regarding this matter, please contact me at (817) 276-6552.
