**Meeting with AREVA NC, Inc. Regarding Gas Centrifuge Application**

U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a meeting with AREVA NC, Inc. to discuss their plans for submitting a license application for a commercial gas centrifuge uranium enrichment plant in the U.S. Representatives from the Department of Energy (DOE) were also in attendance at the meeting.

The schedule proposed by AREVA is to select a site by the end of 2007, submit an application by mid-2008, have a licensing decision issued by mid-2010, start construction in late 2010 and begin operating in 2013. NRC staff stated it would be extremely difficult to prepare and issue an Environmental Impact Statement and Safety Evaluation Report within a 12-15 month period assumed in the AREVA schedule.
