NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Tennessee Valley Authority
Watts Bar 1 and 2

Docket Nos. 50-390 and 50-391
License Nos. CPPR-91 and CPPR-92

The following violation was identified during an inspection conducted on December 21, 1985 - January 20, 1986. The severity level was assigned in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C).

10 CFR 50.55(e)(3) requires that the holder of a construction permit shall submit a written report on a reportable deficiency found in design and construction within thirty (30) days to the appropriate NRC Regional Office. 10 CFR 2.201(a) requires that licensees submit, within the specified time (30 days) of the date of a notice of violation, a written explanation or statement in reply.

Contrary to the above, the Tennessee Valley Authority failed to submit a written report on seven reportable deficiencies within the required 30 day period during the past three months. Also, during this period, the licensee failed to submit a written explanation or statement of reply to two violations provided in Inspection Report 50-390/85-53 and 50-391/85-43 within the 30 days specified in the notice of violation.

This is a severity level V violation (Supplement II).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violation; (2) the reasons for the violation if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved.

Security or safeguards information should be submitted as an enclosure to facilitate withholding it from public disclosure as required by 10 CFR 2.790(d) or 10 CFR 73.21.
