Thank you for your supplemental responses of July 11, 1988, to our Notice of Violation issued on February 24, 1988, concerning activities conducted at your Watts Bar Facility. We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections.

This supplemental response identified four additional open Construction Deficiency Reports (CDR's) that had inadequate final reports submitted to the NRC. We did not evaluate your scheduled submittal dates for the new final reports. You should ensure that the submittal dates you scheduled (in 1989) are consistent with related activities supporting your planned Fall 1990 plant completion.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
