WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - UNITS 1 AND 2 - NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-390, 391/94-37 - CHANGE TO PREVIOUS COMMITMENT

The purpose of this letter is to provide a change to a previous commitment involving violation 50-390, 391/94-37-01, Examples 4, 5 and 6. In the response to these violation examples dated October 18, 1994, TVA committed to retrain the individuals, associated with the identified errors, to the corrective action document revision process.

However, TVA has determined that a more effective corrective action was to establish responsible and accountable designated individuals to ensure the corrective action documents are correct. Further, the previously designated reviewers are required to review these documents to ensure:

1) proper revision approval, 2) proper indication of revision by revision bars, and 3) proper invalidation approvals of these documents are made.

TVA has added these administrative attributes to Business Practice (BP)-383, "Corrective Action Program Guidebook," which is part of the recurrence controls required by revision 4 of Significant Corrective Action Report WBSCA940033. Training is provided to the designated individuals to ensure understanding of the key attributes of BP-383.

Therefore, TVA considers the previous commitment discussed in the October 18, 1994 no longer necessary. If you should have any questions, contact P. L. Pace at (615)-365-1824.
