WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - UNIT 1 - NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-390, 391/94-38 - SUPPLEMENT TO REPLY TO NOTICE OF VIOLATION

The purpose of this letter is to revise the date for the completion of corrective actions stated in TVA's August 13, 1994, response to Notice of Violation 390/94-38-02. In that letter, TVA indicated that retesting of certain temperature sensing devices would be completed by February 15, 1995, in support of the WBN Hot Functional Re-Test milestone. However, some of the devices can not be verified until the reactor vessel head is again installed and the system heated. Accordingly, the completion date for the corrective actions stated in our August 13, 1994, letter will now be scheduled for completion during Hot Functional Test-2.
