As a result of telephone conversations with your Site Licensing staff on January 12, 1987, we understand that your procedure for preventive maintenance, WBN CEP 1.52, will include, by early February 1988, a requirement for an evaluation when PMs cannot be completed. This evaluation would include any compensatory measures and will be documented on the discrepancy report.
