TVA has reevaluated the corrective action methodology described in our April 6, 1987 response to violation 01, part 1, and violation 02. The purpose of this reevaluation is to determine the appropriate examination and testing to ensure ductwork integrity. This deficiency has been addressed in 10 CFR 50.55(e) reports for Significant Condition Reports (SCRs) WBN 7077, WBN MEB 8714, WBN MEB 8721, and WBN MEB 8722 (WBRD-50-390/87-09 and WBRD-50-391/87-09). The final corrective action and any further information will be provided by our 10 CFR 50.55(e) reports.
