
The final response of the heating, ventilating, and air conditioning (HVAC) duct support portion of the subject violation was submitted to NRC on March 30, 1989. A supplemental response was submitted to NRC on July 28, 1989, to address the conduit support portion of the subject violation. These responses committed to complete the corrective actions for HVAC duct supports by May 21, 1990, and the corrective actions for conduit supports by May 26, 1990. TVA is still implementing the corrective action steps for these supports and expects to have these and the associated field modifications completed to support fuel load. This will result in overall completion by July 15, 1991.
