WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT UNIT 1 - FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO DEVIATION 390/85-33-01 - FAILURE TO MAINTAIN 480 VOLT SHUTDOWN BOARD CIRCUIT BREAKER OPEN AND ALARMED IN CONTROL ROOM WHEN THIS CONDITION IS NOT MET

We responded to D. M. Verrelli's letter dated May 7, 1985, report numbers 50-390(85-33) and 50-391/85-28 concerning the subject deviation by letter dated June 14, 1985. Supplemental responses were submitted on August 7, September 11, and October 21, 1985. Below is our fourth supplemental response.

In our third supplemental response to the subject deviation, we committed to complete corrective actions for the review of the plant walkdown (commitments 12.002 and 12.005) by November 1, 1985 and repair door C20 (commitment 10.008) by November 15, 1985. As discussed with Al Ignatonis on January 6, 1986 and Bob Carroll on January 30, and February 20, 1986, these commitments have been missed.

Our commitments 12.002 and 12.005 have been rescheduled to June 1, 1986 as a result of identification, during the review, that for approximately 10% of the areas requiring ALARA review, the walkdown has not been performed. Commitment 10.008 has a new completion date of April 30, 1986 because of problems in determining the appropriate documentation methods. The work on the door itself has been completed.
