- A. 15,000 curies of encapsulated promethium oxide in heat source Model No. 6090-15020.
- B. 30,000 curies of encapsulated promethium oxide in heat source Model No. 6104-25007.
- C. Less than two pounds of depleted uranium to be used as the shield material in heat source Model No. 6104-25007.
