

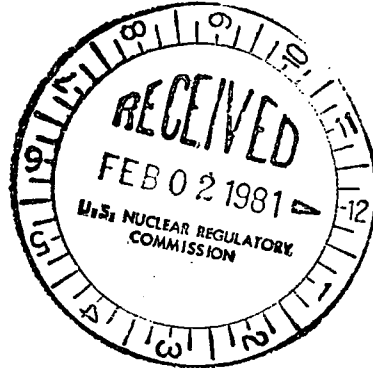

WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - INSPECTION REPORT RII:TDG
50-390/80-24, 50-391/80-18

On June 20, 1980, NRC-OIE Inspector M. Thomas was notified of a reportable deficiency concerning environmental qualification of Class IE equipment. This nonconformance report, NCR SQN EEB 8015, for Sequoyah Nuclear Plant unit 2 was also identified as being applicable to Watts Bar Nuclear Plant. As a result, this was identified as open item 390/80-24-03, 391/80-18-03 in the subject inspection report.

It was later discovered that this NCR was applicable only to Sequoyah; and this situation was discussed with M. Thomas, R. W. Wright, and T. Gibbons of NRC-OIE Region II on October 21, 1980. We therefore request that 390/80-24-03, 391/80-18-03 be removed as an open item for Watts Bar Nuclear Plant.

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
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
