

PVNGS Preparation for Inspection Procedure 95003

In accordance with Reference 1, the purpose of this letter is to report that the preparations for the 95003 inspection, as agreed to with the NRC staff, will be sufficiently completed by October 1, 2007 to facilitate the performance of the inspection. Specifically, in accordance with Reference 2, an in-depth evaluation has been performed to identify site performance deficiencies. From this in-depth evaluation, 12 fundamental overall problem areas were identified and are currently under evaluation or assessment. These are expected to be completed by October 1, 2007. It is possible some of the evaluations/assessments will remain in progress after October 1, 2007 to resolve issues identified during the review processes. Integration of the identified corrective actions from these efforts into the Site Integrated Improvement Plan will be in progress on October 1, 2007.

In accordance with Reference 2, an independent safety culture assessment has also been performed. The final report for this assessment was provided to APS on September 4, 2007. Where appropriate, some of the results from this assessment have been integrated into the evaluations discussed above. In addition, a team is evaluating the overall results of the assessment and identifying corrective actions as well as areas

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for potential further evaluation. Integration of these actions into the Site Integrated Improvement Plan will be in progress on October 1, 2007.

As stipulated in Reference 2, actions to address the root and contributing causes in response to the White and Yellow findings and the substantive cross-cutting areas of human performance and problem identification and resolution are being taken. Progress in addressing these issues will be available for review during the inspection.
