SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-390/90-05 AND 50-391/90-05

This letter forwards a report on the results of a team inspection conducted February 26 - March 1, 1990 at the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant. NRC staff from the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation and consultants from the Brookhaven National Laboratory made up the NRC inspection team.

The team reviewed the implementation of the Watts Bar corrective action programs (CAPs) for heating, ventilation, and air-conditioning (HVAC) and equipment seismic qualification. The team focused its review on the resolution of the technical issues associated with each CAP. Overall, the NRC team found that the technical issues are being adequately addressed in the implementation of the corrective action programs. However, the team's review of a welding issue related to the HVAC duct structural integrity has identified an unresolved item in the HVAC CAP and is further discussed in the enclosed inspection report.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room. If there are any questions concerning this inspection, please contact this office.
