Thank you for your response of September 11, 1990, to our Notice of Violation, issued on August 3, 1990, concerning activities conducted at your Watts Bar facility. We have evaluated your response and found that it did not contain sufficient information to determine if your response meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. Specifically, your response to Example 1 of the violation regarding pressurization of piping above system design pressure appears to be incomplete. There was no discussion as to extent of condition (i.e., review of other surveillance procedures that were modified to gain pump performance data). Additionally, your response did not provide the new piping design pressure or contain information on implementation of the design pressure change, including the requirement for hydrostatic testing. You are therefore requested to provide a supplemental response to the Notice of Violation within 30 days of your receipt of this letter.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
