SUBJECT: ASSIGNMENT OF REPORTING IDENTIFICATION SYMBOL

Dear Ms. Ferek:

This letter is in response to your September 12, 2007, e-mail request to Brian Horn of my staff regarding reporting to the Nuclear Material Management and Safeguard Systems. The symbol “**YKO**” has been assigned as the Reporting Identification Symbol (RIS) for reporting activities involving source material and special nuclear material, as applicable, under your U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued License SNM-2010. This RIS is to be used only for **UNCLASSIFIED** transactions involving material at the National Enrichment Facility located in Eunice, NM. If you wish to convert this RIS from Unclassified use to Classified use, please contact Brian Horn of my staff at (301) 492-3122.

The NRC has specified, in 10 CFR Part 40, 74, 75, and in the attached associated reporting instructions, requirements for submittal to the NRC of material transfer reports whenever certain transfers of special nuclear or source material occur. Reports are required for any transfer, receipt or inventory change of 1 gram or more of contained plutonium, U-233 or U-235 in special nuclear material, 1 kilogram or more uranium or thorium of foreign origin in source material, or the import of 1 kilogram or more of uranium or thorium of any origin.

The NRC utilizes an electronic data processing system to record these reports. All licensees subject to these reporting requirements have been assigned an RIS for identification. The RIS for the facility receiving nuclear material from, or shipping nuclear material to your facility should

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be used in completing the transfer forms (Department of Energy / Nuclear Regulatory Commission Form-741) in accordance with the instructions, and should be used in inventory reports, and other correspondence with the NRC relative to such reports.
