All licensed activities have been transferred from the Annapolis Way facility to the Worth Avenue facilities with records being maintained at the Annapolis Way facility. The individual responsible for overseeing day-to-day activities is Joseph Burke, Safety Officer. There has been no use of licensed material, other than storage, for four years. Only the safety officer and security have keys to the storage area for the units. Environmental, Health and Safety personnel from the corporate office in Michigan visit the sites on an annual basis to perform a safety audit of which radiation safety is a part. Physical inventories are performed every six months and the results relayed to the corporate office. When the program was active, the units were installed in the vehicles to ensure that they fit and the electronics worked. The units were of the licensee if the sealed sources in the chemical detectors worked. Leak testing was not required of the licensee since they are following the Department of the Army (DoA) protocol which only requires testing if the module containing the source is removed or replaced. The modules have never been removed from the units. There is no set time for performing leak tests while the units are kept in storage as per the DoA protocol in the Sealed Source and Device Registry.
