SUBJECT: INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-390/90-24 AND 50-391/90-24

This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspection conducted by G. A. Walton and M. W. Branch on September 22 through October 19, 1990. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Watts Bar facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

The inspection findings indicate that certain activities appeared to violate NRC requirements. The violations, with pertinent references and elements to be included in your response, are described in the enclosed Notice. Within the scope of the inspection, two violations (with multiple examples) were identified. We are particularly concerned about the violations that identify inadequate control of on-going work activities. We conclude that there has been insufficent management attention to assure adequate work controls are being implemented and to assure conditions adverse to quality are resolved adequately and in a timely manner. Although, concerns about Watts Bar work controls were originally addressed in your Employee Concern Special Program in 1985-1987 it appears that not all of the corrective actions outlined in this program have been implemented in a timely manner.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.
