Subject: Uranium Recovery GEIS;

I am responding to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Federal Register notice dated July 24, 2007 regarding the scope of the proposed Generic Environmental Impact Statement ("GEIS") for in situ leach ("ISL") uranium mining.

I write to oppose a GEIS. A generic ruling implementation is not a wise strategy. A generic approach toward nuclear materials regulating, places the public, the environment, and water resources into a greater risk!

The NRC was established to "REGULATE". Efficient, effective timeliness, requires suitable, opportune and appropriate timing. Shortening such, leaves room for failure!

When dealing with regulating radioactive materials, only thorough, accurate, painstaking measures of regulation, should be employed!
