This refers to your letter received August 10, 2007, notifying the NRC of a name change. Based on the information provided in your letter and your facsimile dated 8/16/2007, it appears no change of control of licensed activities has taken place and Healthsouth – Ballas Outpatient, now known as Ballas Outpatient Surgery Center, L. P., d/ba Ballas Outpatient Surgery Center remains responsible for all licensed activities under License No. 24-32139-01. Therefore, your license has been amended to reflect the new name of your licensed program.

Please note that we have reformatted Subitem Nos. 6, 7, and/or 9 and Condition No. 12 at this time to remove all references to excluded authorizations, including but not limited to authorizations such as “generators, xenon-133, aerosols, etc.”

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.
