WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 390, 391/93-23 - SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF VIOLATION


This supplements TVA's letter of June 7, 1993, which responded to NRC's May 7, 1993 Notice of Violation concerning improper design control (390/93-23-02). TVA's June 7, 1993 letter committed to evaluate whether other design changes (DCNs) (i.e., in addition to the cited DCN) could have resulted in improper issuance of drawings which conflict with the field configuration. The cited violation had occurred due to a failure to properly consider all related design changes (i.e., predecessor relationships) for collective impact on drawing issuance.

The evaluation included a review of 10 electrical and mechanical design changes (DCNs) issued in 1992 or 1993, nine of which involved at least one predecessor DCN. The evaluation determined that predecessor change documents were correctly identified in eight of nine cases. Although in one example a predecessor DCN was not referenced in its associated successor DCN, both DCNs had been correctly incorporated into the affected drawing in the proper sequence. Based on the results of this evaluation, no further reviews are considered necessary.

Current engineering procedures and drawing practices ensure that when appropriate consideration is given to predecessor DCNs, issued drawings will incorporate the required information from predecessor and successor DCNs and will agree with the plant configuration.
