WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN)-UNIT 1-SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO NRC VIOLATION 390/93-27-01 REQUESTING AN EXTENSION TO TWO COMMITMENT COMPLETION DATES

TVA letter to NRC, July 15, 1993, Supplemental Response to Reference: Notice of Violation 390/93-27-01, Example 1

The purpose of this letter is to notify NRC that additional time is needed to complete two commitments in the referenced letter that were indicated as having a completion date of November 12, 1993. The two commitments are as follows:

- (1)TVA will perform a select sample of workplans and work orders which installed or modified Namco limit switches of the type addressed in Significant Corrective Action Report (SCAR) WBSCA930068.
- (2)TVA will perform a sample of completed and vaulted workplans and work orders to verify the correct utilization of vendor criteria.

TVA is in the process of establishing a reliable data base (listing) of total work orders and a listing of which work orders installed or modified NAMCO Limit Switches. Several approaches are being considered but require additional research to determine the most accurate method. One difficult area encountered is that the data base of the population of work orders closed include many canceled work orders which compromise the list of completed work orders. An attempt is being made to segregate and determine the verified completed work orders.

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Most of the sampling has been performed on the workplans, and the results are under evaluation to determine required actions.

TVA expects to have the population determined, the sampling performed and the results of the sampling completed by January 7, 1994.

The enclosure to this letter states the commitments and their revised completion date.
