WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - COMMITMENT IDENTIFIED IN RESPONSE TO SEVERITY LEVEL IV VIOLATION 390, 391/92-34-02

This letter provides an extension to a commitment identified in TVA's response to Violation 390, 391/92-34-02. That response was submitted to NRC December 22, 1992.

In the corrective steps taken to avoid further violations, TVA stated that the Plant Access Section will be staffed with a supervisor to ensure that the elements of the Plant Access program are properly implemented. Completion of this commitment was delayed by TVA's initiative to reevaluate plant staffing levels, based on the recommendations of the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO). To date, TVA has posted the supervisory position, and the vacancy announcement has expired. TVA anticipates that selection for this position and implementation will occur on or before August 1, 1993.
