NOTICE OF VIOLATION

(NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-390/93-58 AND 50-391/93-58)

This refers to the NRC inspection conducted by G. A. Walton on August 1 through August 31, 1993. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Watts Bar facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice).

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

Violation B in the enclosed Notice, which involves inadequate engineering calculations, several of which were performed without using an approved calculation procedure, was identified through an NRC review of the Sargent and Lundy Vertical Slice Review (VSR) results. These calculation mistakes resulted in non-conservative safety margins and in some cases, hardware modifications were required. We are concerned about these findings in that our review was not all-inclusive and that similar problems may exist in other calculations. In addition to your response to Violation B, you should provide an evaluation of the necessity for you to re-review the results of the Sargent and Lundy VSR and other calculations performed outside your approved procedures.
