WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-390, 391/93-58 - REPLY TO NOTICES OF VIOLATION - SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE

The purpose of this letter is to notify NRC of a schedule revision for a commitment made in response to the subject notices of violation (NOVs). TVA responded to the subject NOVs on November 3, 1993. For NOV 50-390, 391/93-58-02, Example 2, TVA stated that deficiency notices (DNs) generated before August 26, 1993, were being sent to Site Licensing for performance of potential reportability screening and/or reportability evaluation under the criteria for 10 CFR 50.55(e). The review of these DNs was scheduled to be complete by March 31, 1994.

To date, approximately 1,220 DNs generated prior to August 26, 1993, have been transmitted to Site Licensing. Of this population, 958 DNs have been screened and/or evaluated. The total number of DNs received by Site Licensing far exceeds the anticipated population. Additional time is required to complete the DN screenings and/or evaluations. This action is now scheduled to be complete by June 3, 1994.
