
In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 71.1 and 10 CFR 71.38, NAC International (NAC) hereby requests the timely renewal of U.S. NRC CoC No. 9270 for the Model No. UMS<sup>®</sup> Universal Transport Cask Package (Package Identification No. USA/9270/B(U)F-96), which will expire October 31, 2007.

NAC has reviewed the current UMS<sup>®</sup> Universal Transport Cask Package operating procedures, Chapter 7, and maintenance program, Chapter 8, of Reference 2 and found no revision of the SAR is necessary at this time.

Upon its approval, NAC is planning to incorporate the high burnup fuel content amendment currently under review with the NRC for the NAC-UMS<sup>®</sup> Universal Storage System, along with some minor updates/changes, into the UMS<sup>®</sup> Universal Transport Cask SAR. The NRC will be notified in a timely manner prior to the submittal of an amendment request.
