
Dear Sir,

We request the removal of Source Material, Source Uranium and Source Thorium, from the CDC Materials License (No. 10-06772-01).

We are in compliance with 10 CFR §40.22, in that we have neither used nor transferred more than fifteen (15) pounds of source material at any one time for research, development, educational, commercial or operational purposes. We shall further comply with the above regulation and not receive more than a total of 150 pounds of source material in any one calendar year.

We have an existing Radiation Safety Program, which is well equipped to monitor area surveys and personnel exposure, ensure that all radiation safety practices are followed, maintain accurate inventories and safeguard these radionuclides from unauthorized access and removal.
