Dear Sir or Madam:

I am requesting an amendment to license No. 21-04109-16 for Henry Ford Hospital's broad scope medical license. This amendment request is being made to transfer the Bon Secours Cottage Health Services site from License number 21-16868-01 to license No. 21-04109-16. This is a result of the sale and division of the Bon Secours cottage hospital services. The vast majority of licensed activities under the Bon Secours License number 21-16868-01 will go to the Beaumont Health System. One location of use on the Bon Secours license will become a location of use on the Henry Ford Hospital's broad scope medical license (Bon Secours Cottage Health Services, 159 Kercheval Avenue, Grosse Point Farms, MI 48236). Once this amendment has been completed, the usage of material at this site will be conducted in accordance with Henry Ford Hospital's broad scope medical license commitments.

The license amendment will follow the format suggested by Guidance About Changes of Control and About Bankruptcy Involving Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear Materials Licenses (NUREG-1556, Vol. 15).

Items Required by NUREG 1556 Volume 15

5.1 Description of Transaction

The Cottage Health Services site which will be renamed Henry Ford Cottage Hospital and brought under to license Henry Ford Hospital's broad scope medical license (license No. 21-04109-16). The vast majority of licensed

activities under the Bon Secours License number 21-16868-01 will go to the Beaumont Health System. The current uses at the site are 10 CFR 35.100 and 10 CFR 35.200 uses (uptake, dilution, excretion, imaging and localization studies). No therapy administrations will be performed at the Cottage site and none of the planned uses will require a written directive. Standard sealed sources used to calibrate and test equipment required for these studies will also be needed. The license contacts will become the same as that for Henry Ford Hospital [Alan M. Jackson, MS CHP and Donald Peck, PhD, DABR at (313) 916-27391.

5.2 Changes of Personnel

No new persons will be listed under Henry Ford Hospital's broad scope medical license since the radiation safety committee can approve users.

5.3 Changes of Location, Equipment, and Procedures

Initially, there will not be any changes in location, equipment or procedures at the Cottage site. The existing uses will simply continue. Over time, minor changes will occur, as would happen with any program, but none are currently planned which would require license amendments.

5.4 Surveillance Records

A review of the records was conducted. In general, radiation safety support at this site has been conducted by Laura Smith, MS, DABR of Radiological Physics Consultants. Henry Ford Hospital Radiation Safety staff met with Ms. Smith on 8/20/07 at the Cottage site and conducted a review of the radiological conditions and records at the site. At the time of the review all required surveillance had been performed, documented, and reviewed, including the results. Please note that the contract with Radiological Physics will continue during the transfer stages and will be seamlessly picked up over the 90 day Radiological Physics Consultants contract cancellation period by the Henry Ford Hospital Radiation Safety Office Staff. The records at the site will be maintained in accordance with NRC requirements.

The licensed uses at the site were limited to short-lived diagnostic Nuclear medicine uses. At the time of our survey the Nuclear Medicine area had not been recently used so that, largely due to decay, no areas of contamination were present and the ambient radiation levels at background levels (less than 0.03 mR/h) except in the proximity of the sealed sources at the site which are stored

in shielded containers and properly secured. No therapeutic uses of licensed materials were ever used at this site.

5.5 Decommissioning and Related Records Transfers

As indicated in section 5.4 above, there does not appear to be a need to decommission the site prior to transferring the site to the Henry Ford Hospital license since the short lived materials used have already decayed to background levels. We will assume responsibility for all of the licensed uses at the site. As stated above, we are knowledgeable of the extent and levels of residual contamination, which appears to be nonexistent, and are aware of the applicable decommissioning requirements.

The records at the site will remain at the Cottage location until transfer of the facility occurs. After that time some of the records may be secured at the Henry Ford Radiation Safety Office. We commit to maintain the Cottage records as required by NRC regulations.

No areas of contamination are present and the ambient radiation levels at background levels (less than 0.03 mR/h) except in the proximity of the sealed sources at the site which are stored in shielded containers and properly secured. Thus, no decontamination is needed to prepare the facility for decommissioning before the change of control. The only materials at the site with a half life greater than 65 days are sealed sources.

5.6 Transferee's Commitment to Abide by the Transferor's Commitments

Since use at this site will become subject to the Henry Ford Hospital license we do commit to following the constraints, license conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments identified in and attributed to for Henry Ford Hospital's broad scope medical license Number 21-04109-16. Specifically we do not commit to the constraints, license conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments identified in and attributed to the Bon Secours License number 21-16868-01.

6 Bankruptcy

This section is not applicable since this is simply the sale of a location rather than a bankruptcy.
