SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION
(NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-390/94-79 AND 50-391/94-79)

Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by B. Crowley of this office on November 14-18, November 28 to December 2, and December 12-13, 1994. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Watts Bar facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

The purpose of this inspection was to verify completion of corrective actions for the Welding Corrective Action Program (CAP). Based on the review documented in the enclosed Inspection Report and the referenced inspection activities, we concluded that the CAP has been adequately implemented. There are two items that we will review further as completion and turn over of systems continues. First, in accordance with the Inspector Followup Item identified in the report, we will review the ASME N-5 Code Data Report Supplement process as it progresses. Second, during review of the N-5 Supplement process, we will review your corrective actions for our previously identified Unresolved Item relative to the accountability of welds in your Welding Information Monitoring System (WMIS). We will also continue to inspect on-going welding activities.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). Although Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office, within 30 days of your receipt of this Notice, a written statement of explanation, we note that the Violation has been corrected and those actions were reviewed during this inspection. Therefore, no response to this Notice is required.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
