The purpose of this letter is to notify NRC of a change in commitment for TVA's response to Notice of Violation 50-390, 391/94-76-01.

In order to correct a previous example of an individual performing functions without documented qualifications, the Plant Completions Group (PCG) manager committed to personally selecting field engineering personnel. Although the present PCG manager retains this responsibility, a decision has been made to delegate the selection process to a member of the management team who will review qualifications based on specific instructions provided by the PCG manager.
