Request to Name Additional Authorized Users of Radioactive Materials

Bryn Mawr College would like to name the following two individuals as authorized users of radioactive materials under Condition 11 of our Materials License:

Susan A. White, Ph.D.

Dr. White is a Professor of Chemistry who has been working with radioisotopes in the study of RNA structure since 1985. Her 20+ years of experience includes work with sulfur 35-, phosphorus 32-, and tritium-labeled compounds. Her training and experience was obtained at Johns Hopkins University, Yale University (doctoral and post doctoral work respectively), and at Bryn Mawr College. She anticipates working with phosphorus 32 as an authorized user, possessing and using quantities of up to 250 microCuries of P-32 per experiment.

Monica Chander, Ph.D.

Dr. Chander is a newly hired Assistant Professor of Biology, who has been working with radioisotopes since 1993. Her nearly 14 years of experience and training with radioactive materials was obtained at the University of Connecticut and the Harvard School of Public Health. She has previously worked with P-32, S-35, tritium, Mn-54, and Zn-65. She anticipates working only with P-32 in her biochemistry research work at Bryn Mawr College. She expects to work with a maximum of 1 milliCurie of P-32 at any time.
