Dear Ms. Henderson:

I am writing to inform you that there was a robbery at my office at Penn Cardiology at Cherry Hill, 1400 East Route 70, Cherry Hill, New Jersey 08034 on the night of September 19, 2007. Money and a few objects were taken throughout the office. They also broke into the hot lab and stole our survey meter with an attached small sealed Cesium source used for calibration. This robbery was reported to the Cherry Hill police department. The office does have an alarm system. The room where nuclear cardiology is is locked with a separate locked door for the hot lab where the survey meter is kept. As an additional precaution since this robbery, we are placing a second lock onto the hot lab, the combination of which will only be known to the nuclear medicine technologist, myself and Nuclear Diagnostics, Inc. which delivers and picks up our radiopharmaceuticals.
